

Player Code of Conduct

The following standards are established by the Society and govern the behavior of all Pacific Eagles players before, during and after the games and practices:

- Never address remarks at opposing coaches, players, referees and spectators (except for genuine friendship, respect or in response to a question by a referee).
- Never retaliate when fouled.
- Never retaliate when fouled.
- Avoid comments or gestures that express disagreement with the official's call.
- Displays of temper will not be tolerated on the field or in playing area
- Convey a consistently positive attitude toward your teammates or coaches. Your true strength of character will be displayed on the field.
- Play for fun.
- Obey rules of the game.
- Be a good sport. Cheer all good plays.
- Follow the Golden Rule: Treat others as you would like to be treated.
- Accept defeat with dignity. Good losers earn more respect than bad winners

Violence and/or repeated demonstrations of conduct that are in direct violation of the rules of the game and result in a disqualification from any contest, including the combination of caution offenses by individual league rules that causes a player to sit out a game, will be dealt with severely as follows:

| 3rd misconduct: | - Remainder of season suspension plus incident committee hearing to determine future eligibility with the society |

Note: The Incident Committee is empowered to skip directly to the third step if an incident is deemed sufficiently serious.
